The Worthington Stamp Club prepared a special event cover to commemorate the April 8, 2024 Total Solar Eclipse. A total of 102 covers were cancelled at Sunbury, Ohio on April 8.

Sunbury, Ohio (pun intended) was in the path of totality during the eclipse. 100 of the covers are numbered on the back in pencil (1/100, 2/100, etc.) to indicate the limitation of the edition. Two additional "specimen" covers were prepared with no marking on the back. One was presented to the Postmaster of Sunbury and the second one to the postal clerk who did the bulk of the work cancelling the covers. Mid-way in the cancelling process a second postal clerk helped cancel covers. However, he used a different device using red rather than black ink. Sixteen covers have red cancellations. The retail prices of the covers are:

<u>Normal (black cancel) covers</u>; \$5 each. For Columbus Philatelic Club members, a discounted price of \$4 each.



<u>Red cancel covers</u> (of which only 12 remain); \$7 each. For Columbus Philatelic Club members, a discounted price of \$6 each.
